Help your child get ready to read with

6 Skills of Early Literacy!

1 Narrative Skills

Tell each other stories and encourage pretend play.

Letter Knowledge

Help your child learn the first letter in their name and find it in books, on signs and on labels.

3 Print Awareness

Help your child discover how to hold a book, follow the words and turn the pages.

Vocabulary

Teach your child the names of things, like apple, dog, car and tree.

5 Print Motivation

Find books that fit your child's interests and read them often.

Phonological Awareness

Sing songs, play games and share rhymes to help your child play with the sounds in words.
