Michael DeLalla Concludes Spring Happy Hour Music Series at Laramie County Library

On May 10th at 5:30 p.m. in the Cottonwood Room, Laramie County Library will conclude its spring Happy Hour music series with a performance by guitarist Michael DeLalla. DeLalla has been practicing his craft for nearly thirty years and his prowess on 12-string, classical, and steel-string acoustic guitar is evident in his stunning renditions of original compositions and traditional arrangements. His classical sound is combined with jazz, Celtic, and folk stylings to create performances that have dazzled audiences around the world.

Winner of Laramie County Library's One World Prairie Guitar Contest in 2018, Michael DeLalla has garnered praise from audiences, critics, and peers. Matt Fink from the *All Music Guide* describes DeLalla as, "one of the very best acoustic guitarists in the world," and states that his music is "of the most exquisite order." DeLalla describes his concerts as "journeys" and he invites audiences to come experience a musical narrative of his travels from around the world as he incorporates influences from Japanese koto music to North African ouds.

Michael DeLalla is the last in a three part music series at Laramie County Library. Attendees are invited to come listen to the concert while enjoying the company of friends and family.
