

# Valentine's Pop-Up Cards

## Instructions:

1. Fold a piece of cardstock paper in half. If you would like the card to be smaller you can cut your cardstock to a smaller size before folding.
2. Cut two parallel slits on the folded side of the paper, about one inch apart and about one inch long.
3. Fold the tab you have cut up, and crease it. Open up your card and fold the tab inward, towards the center of your card.
4. Decide what you want to pop-up in your card. This is what you will glue to the square tab. If you would like more than one thing to pop-up you can create more tabs.
5. Decorate the background and the front of the card!
6. You can always make your own items to pop-up in the card, it doesn't have to be what is included in the craft kit.

## Extra:

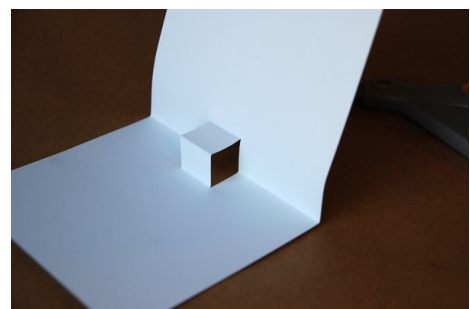
1. If you would like to hide the tabs on your card you can glue another piece of cardstock to the outside of your card.



## Materials:

- Cardstock
- Paper Cutouts
- Patterned Heart Stickers
- Foam Heart Stickers
- Ribbon
- Crayons\*
- Glue\*
- Scissors\*
