

Yodeler Hat

Instructions:

1. Fold your construction paper in half, with the short edges together (hamburger style).
2. Your construction paper should have the edges facing you. Take the top corners of the creased side of your paper and fold them towards the center. It will look like two triangles, and the bottoms will not touch the edge of your paper.
3. Fold the flaps at the bottom of your hat up towards the top to form the brim. You will fold the flaps so that you have one on each side of the hat.
4. Tuck in the outside corners of the flaps so that they line up with edge of the hat.
5. Glue the corners of the flaps to your hat.
6. Glue your feather on. Most Yodelers hats have the feather in the middle but if you want to put it somewhere else you can.
7. Optional: If you would like to, you can add other decorations to your hat! You can use crayons, markers, or colored pencils to draw on it or add other things like stickers.
8. Optional: You can also use the sting included to make a chin strap to help your hat stay on. To do this you will need to punch a hole in the bottom middle of each side of your hat. Then you will need to cut your sting in half and tie each to one side of the hat.
9. Enjoy your hat! Can you spot a hat like yours in the Pint Sized Polkas video?

Materials:

- Construction paper
- Feather
- String
- Glue*
- Hole punch*
- Optional: Coloring utensils (crayons, markers, colored pencils)*
