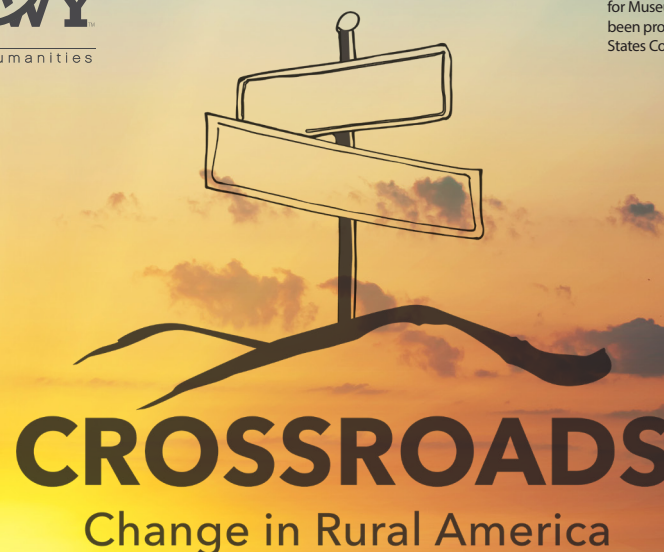

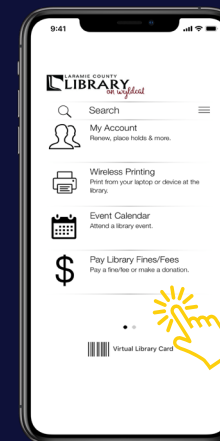
FAFSA Workshop
