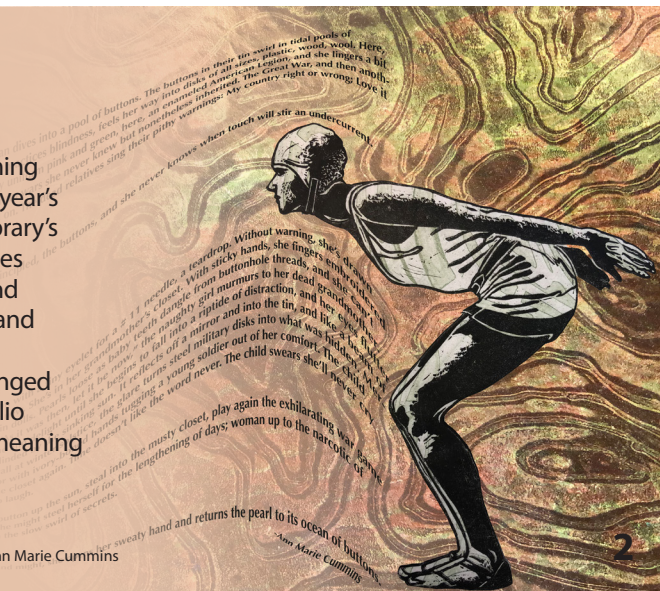
Habitat: Artists' Books

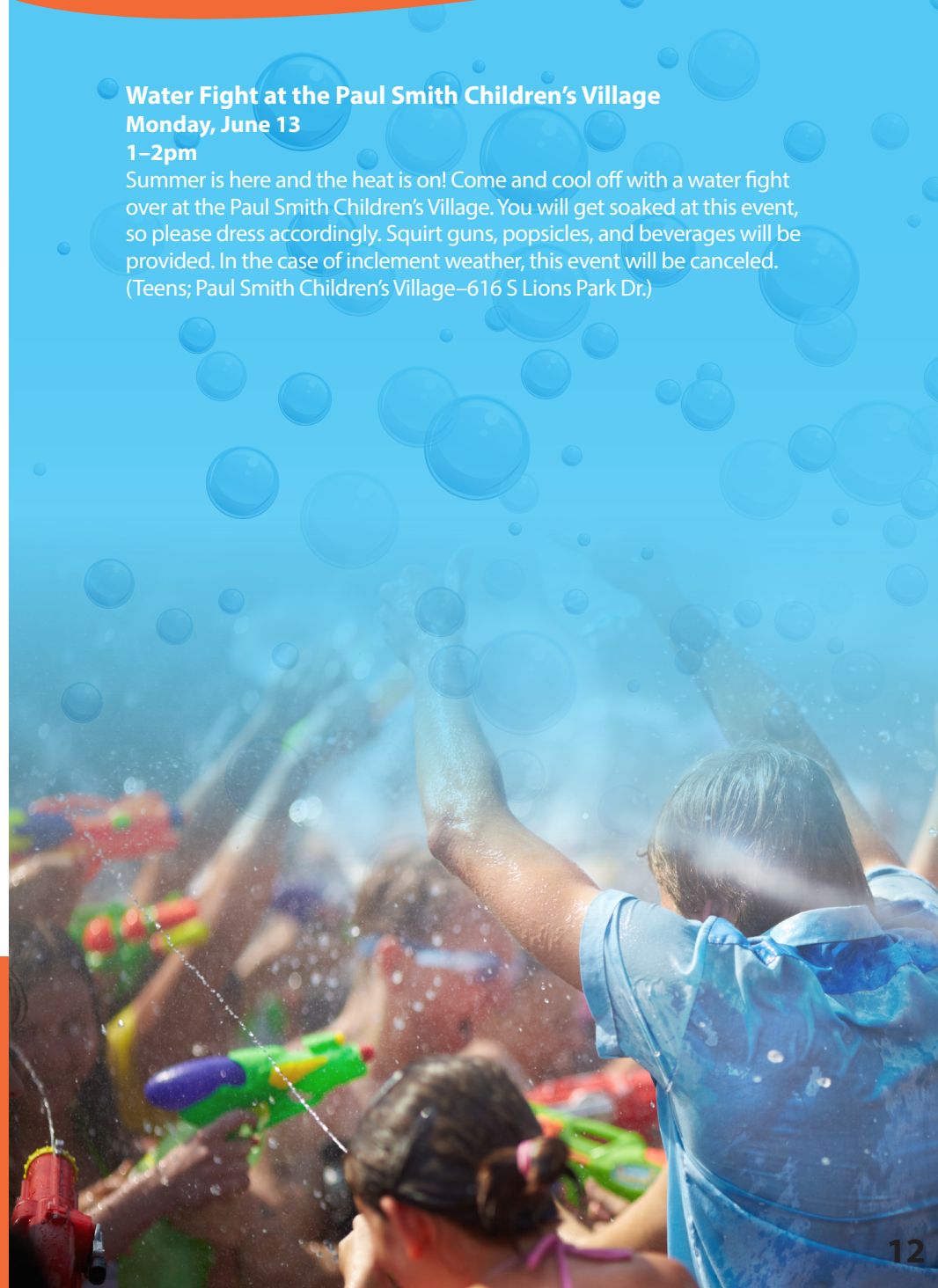

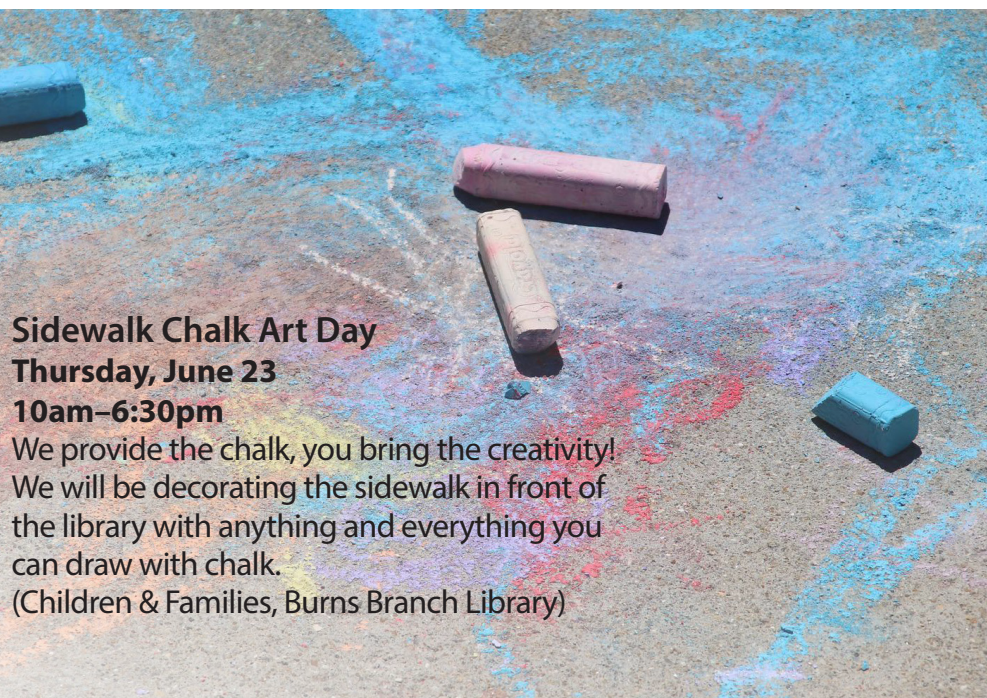
